



## Spezification for Data Delivery DDP-Images on Data Medium

For the Delivery of DDP Images on Data Medium (CD-R, DVD-R, DVD+R) there are the following specification to use.

(DDP=Disc Description Protocol describes structure from Files/Folders on the Disc that is used for CD/DVD Production

- For DDP-Images there will be no check from Content. The Data will be used "as is"
- acceptable DDP-Standard ist DDP 1.0, DDP 2.0, DDP 2.10.
- One Data Medium only have to contian <u>one</u> DDP.
- All DDP-Files have to be in the Root-Directory on the Data Medium.
- The Data Medium has to be marked like : "Attention: content is DDP-Image!".
  (Please mark Box and Label)
- The Data Medium additional has to be marked for Format which is use for like: "Replica is CD-Audio" (or CD-ROM, Enhanced CD, DVD-Video, DVD-ROM, DVD-Audio, etc.).
- When the DDP is for a DVD-9 there must be 2 Data Medium, one Data Medium per Layer. The Data Medium hast to be marked like "Layer 0" or "Layer 1".
